AUTO- PAY YOUR ASSESSMENTS

ARCHITECTURAL GUIDELINES FOR NORTHWOOD POINTE

If you are considering to conduct exterior improvements to your home, please keep in mind that you must submit an architectural application for approval prior to commencing work. The review process allows 30 days for review of your submittal beginning from the time the completed application is received. Incomplete applications will be sent back for re-submittal and will not be considered. Due to the volume of submittals, Management cannot expedite the review of any applications; applications will be processed in the order in which the applications are received.
